In-Home Health Aide Job Responsibilities:

- Enables patients to stay in their homes by monitoring and recording patient condition, providing support and personal services, and teaching families.
- Monitors patient condition by observing physical and mental condition, intake and output, and exercise.
- Supports patients by providing housekeeping and laundry services, and other household requirements including running errands.
- Prepare and serve meals and snacks.
- Assists patients by providing personal services, such as, bathing, dressing, and grooming.
- Assist patients to care for themselves by teaching use of cane or walker, special utensils to eat, special techniques and equipment for personal hygiene.
- Empower family members to care for the patient by teaching appropriate ways to lift, turn, and re-position the patient.
- Records patient information by making entries in the patient journal and notifying nursing and staff supervisors of changing or unusual conditions.
- Maintains a safe, secure, and healthy patient environment by following OSHA, Blood Borne Pathogen and Infection Control standards and procedures.
- Uphold confidentiality and HIPPA procedures.
- Sustain security precautions, and following prescribed dietary requirements and nutrition standards.
